- Building Futures Program
 - An immersive one-year program for grade 10 students students are able to earn credits toward their diploma while working with qualified tradespeople to build a house from the ground up
 - The garage of a new home under construction is transformed into an onsite classroom where students learn academic courses from certified teachers employed by GSACRD
 - Students interested in this program can register at Morinville Community High School, École Secondaire St. Albert Catholic High School, or St. Gabriel Education Centre – students will be required to participate in an interview and provide references as part of the application process
 - A \$300 fee per student is anticipated and will be re-evaluated yearly and adjusted as needed
 - The program will aim to accommodate 24-30 students
 - By offering this program through GSACRD, it demonstrates the following:
 - a. A commitment to trades education for students
 - A desire to help grow the Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) – the RAP program is a cost-effective way to provide trades education while also preparing students for the world of work
 - c. Opportunity for GSACRD students to pursue trades education in a faith-based environment
 - d. Strengthened presence in the community as innovative educators
- Alberta Catholic School Trustees Association (ACSTA)
 - ACSTA has released a revised handbook for the upcoming election

- Student Engagement
 - On Dec.18/24, the Board of Trustees established an ad hoc Student Engagement Committee to discuss the establishment of a formalized process for board and student engagement.

- The goal of the initiative is to enhance student voice and participation in the governance process by creating opportunities for meaningful dialogue between students and trustees.
- The committee identified several key considerations for the initiative:
 - a. Focus on grades 7 to 12 students each school will nominate two students
 - b. Frequency of meetings the group will meet twice per year (once per semester)
 - c. First meeting details possible date for the inaugural meeting is April 22/25 at the Division Services Centre food and drinks will be provided
 - d. Student nomination process the superintendent will request school administrators to submit the names of two student representatives from their respective schools
 - e. Purpose of initial meeting to serve as an introduction to the role of trustees, an overview of the board's responsibilities, and an explanation of the student engagement initiative also provides an opportunity to gather student ideas and input for the committee's future direction
